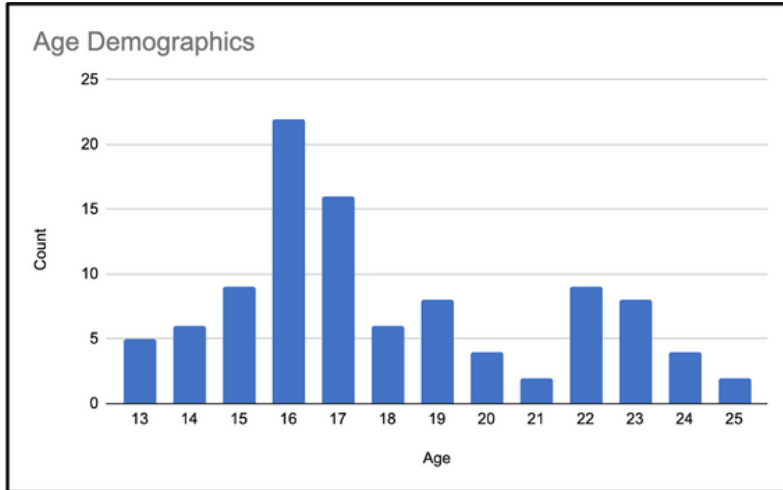


Nate's Place

YEAR-IN-REVIEW

From February 2023 to May 2024, **Nate's Place has successfully supported teens and young adults ranging from ages 13 to 25 years old.**

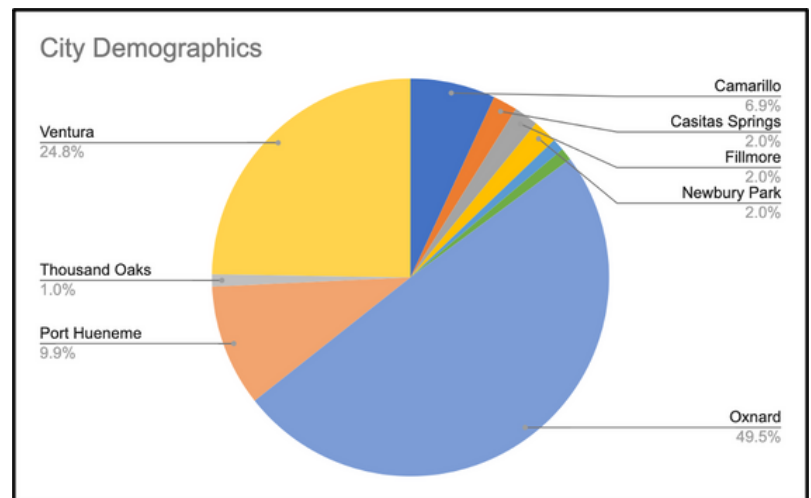
The majority of individuals currently served are 16 and 17 years of age. The majority of our participants are sophomores to seniors in high school.

WIDE REACH

Nate's Place has been able to service individuals and families throughout Ventura County. By offering transportation to and from the center, Nate's Place provides accessibility to individuals in outlying areas. Located in Oxnard, CA, 51.5% of the population served comes from 9 of the surrounding cities. **Clients from Oxnard make up 49.5%.**

Nate's Place also extends its reach outside of the center by conducting **Teen Intervene Prevention groups in 3 schools in Ventura County where a total of 45 teens are served.** This program will expand to two more schools by the end of June 2024.

As of May 2024, Nate's Place has supported 146 teens and young adults.

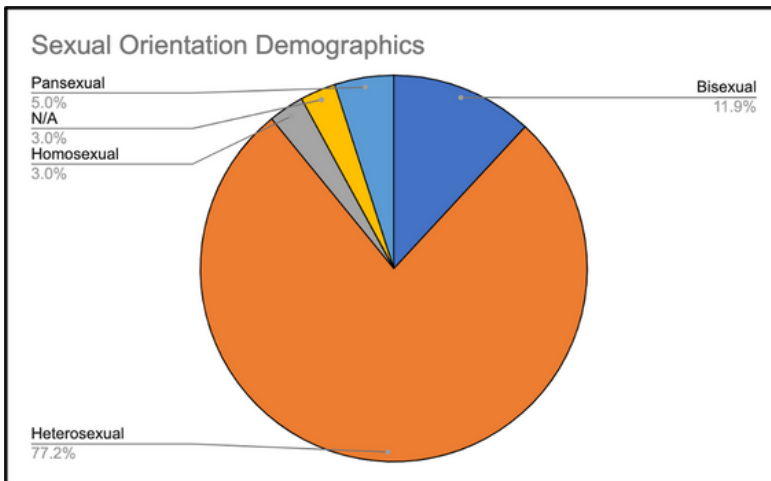
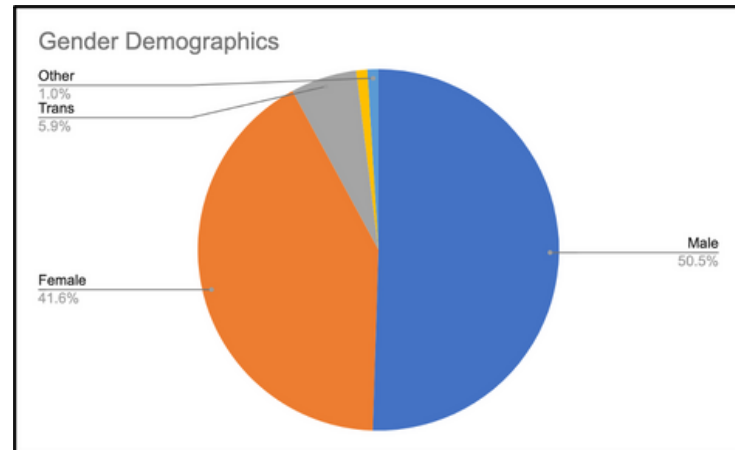
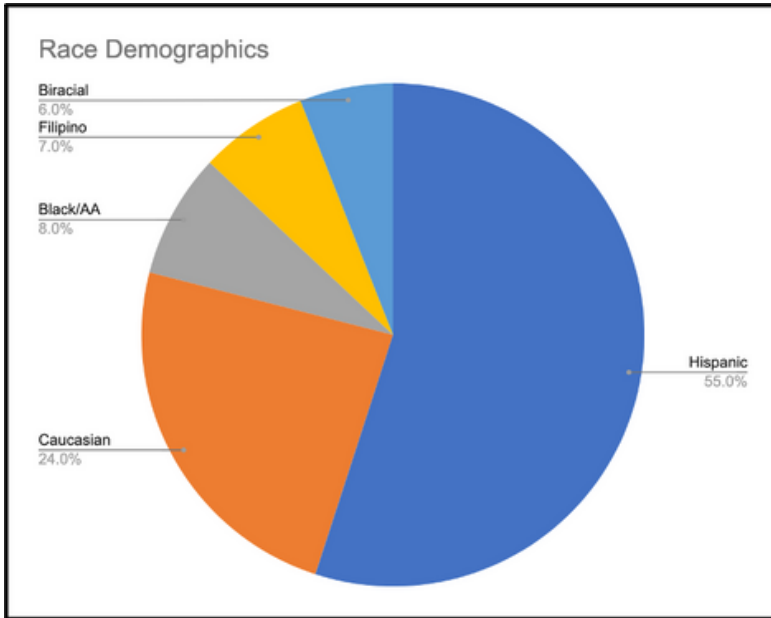
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DEMOGRAPHICS

Nate's Place has been welcoming to all ethnicities. As of May 2024, **Nate's Place has a total of 76% BIPOC population.** The Nate's Place staff reflects the population by having over half of its staff being bilingual (Spanish/English).

Nate's Place has a population of **50.5% male, 41.6% female, and 5.9% transgender.**



Nate's Places is proud to be a safe haven for young adults to feel comfortable about their gender and sexuality, and also to learn from one another. **77.2% identify as heterosexual, 11.9% bisexual, 3% homosexual, 5% pansexual, and 3% choosing not to identify.**

Nate's Place has shown continuous support to all demographics in regards to gender, sexual orientation, and race. The BIPOC population at Nate's Place exceeds the racial demographic makeup of Ventura County, proving to be a great resource to under-represented and minority groups in the county.

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CONNECTING TO THE COMMUNITY

Nate's Place has successfully organized nine **Community Prevention Talk** events for youth, parents, and community partners to receive free education on critical topics such as vaping, marijuana, nicotine, fentanyl, and opioids.



With guest speakers that are subject-matter experts, participants have been overwhelmingly pleased with the detailed information they are provided and the length of time of these events. Major highlights are the testimonials from guest speakers that share personal experiences and their journey to recovery.

In 2023, Nate's Place reached nearly **300 attendees in the 7 events** held. As of 2024, two events have taken place with four more scheduled by the end of June. With majority positive feedback from participants, **85% of those that were surveyed strongly agree that the subject matter is relevant and changed their view on the topic.**

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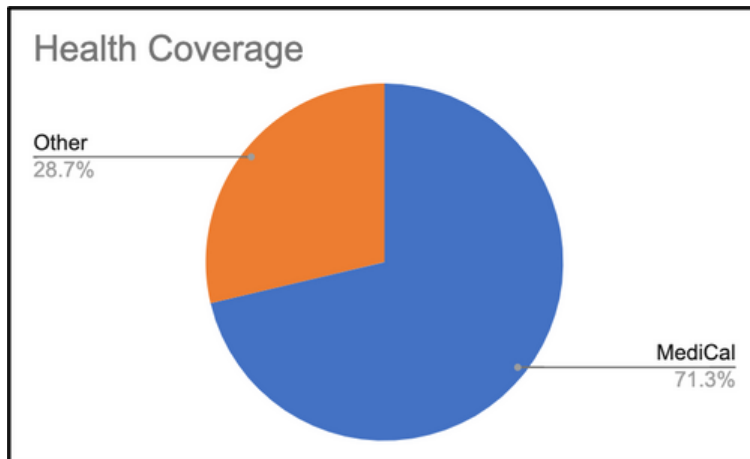
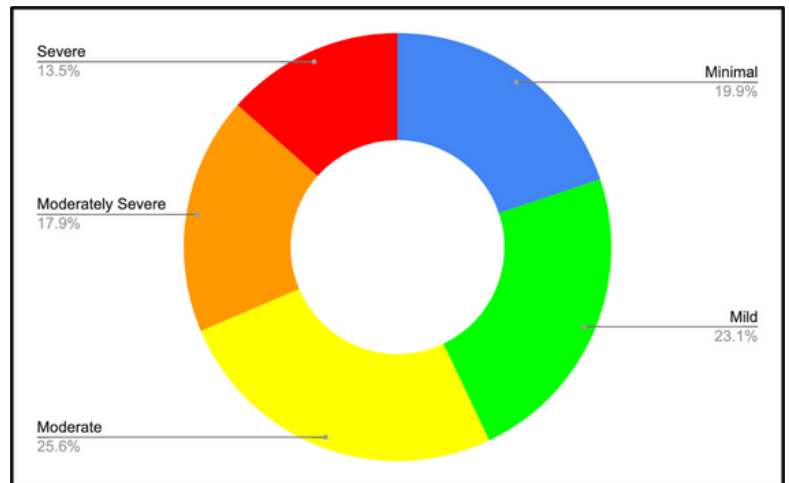
IMPACT OF PROGRAM

Each participant completes an industry-standard self-report questionnaire to measure their mental health at the time of entering the program. The questionnaire is provided every three months for updates.

68.6% of participants have shown an improvement in their levels by **going from severe and moderately severe depression to moderate, mild, and minimal depression.**

Substance Use

Participants that have attended programming 3 or more days each week have stated they are **"Very Motivated"** in reducing their use of alcohol and/or drugs.



As of May 2024, **71.3% of current Nate's Place participants are enrolled in Medi-Cal.** The young participants and their families benefit greatly from the free services and on-going support provided by Nate's Place: A Wellness and Recovery Center.
