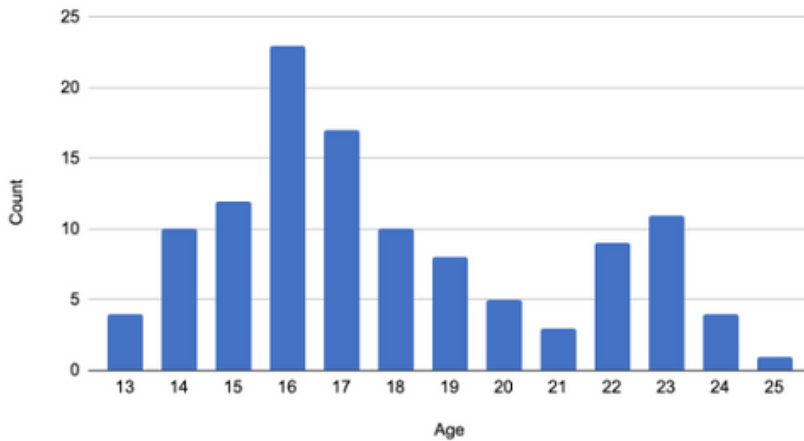

IMPACT STATEMENT: Demographics and Outcomes

Age Demographics



YEAR-IN-REVIEW

From February 2023 to July 2024, Nate's Place has successfully supported teens and young adults ranging from ages 13 to 25 years old.

The majority of individuals currently served are 16 and 17 years of age. The majority of our participants are sophomores to seniors in high school.

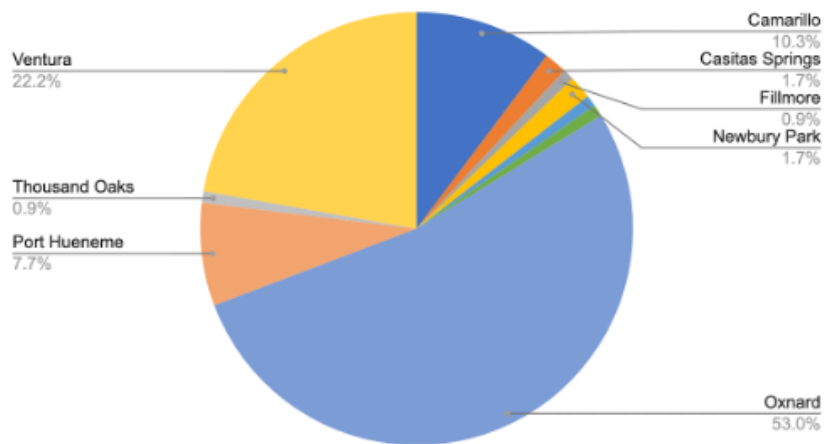
As of July 2024, Nate's Place has supported 222 teens and young adults, which includes 105 teens through our Teen Intervene Prevention group at schools. We typically have 50 to 55 youth enrolled at our center.

WIDE REACH

Nate's Place has been able to service individuals and families throughout Ventura County. By offering transportation to and from the center, Nate's Place provides accessibility to individuals in outlying areas. Located in Oxnard, CA, 47% of the population served come from 9 of the surrounding cities. **Clients from Oxnard make up 53%.**

Nate's Place extends its reach outside of the center by conducting **Teen Intervene Prevention groups in 4 schools in Ventura County where a total of 105 teens are served.** More schools are planned to be added by the end of 2024.

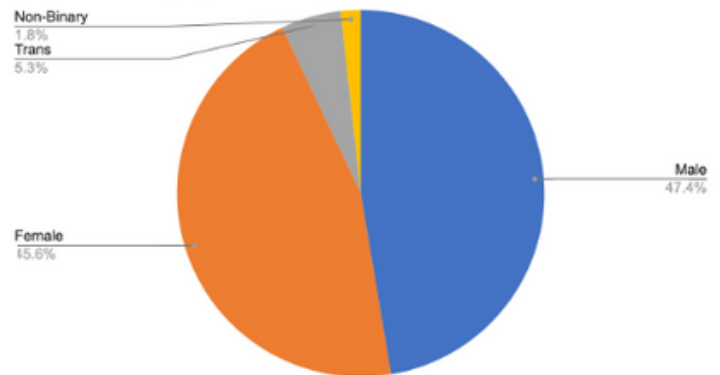

DEMOGRAPHICS

Nate's Place has been welcoming to all ethnicities. As of June 2024, **Nate's Place has a total of 79.5% BIPOC population.** The Nate's Place staff reflects the population by having over half of its staff being bilingual (Spanish/English).

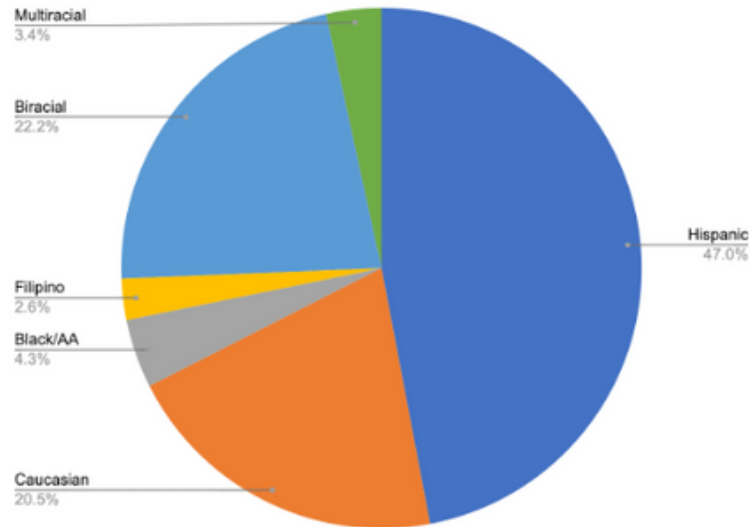
Nate's Place has a population of **47.4% male, 45.6% female, 5.3% transgender, and 1.8% non-binary.**

Gender Demographics



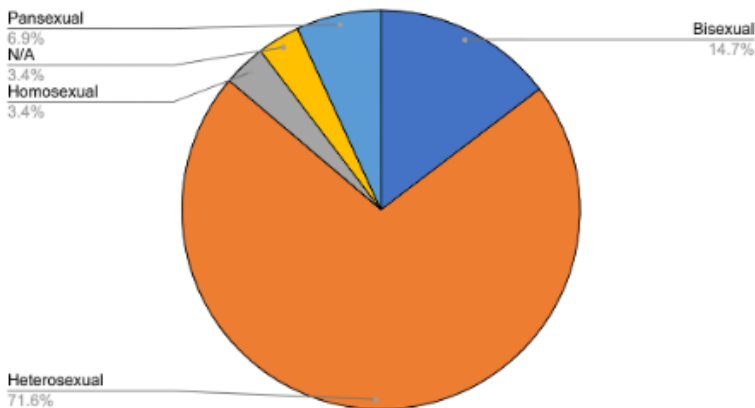
Nate's Places is proud to be a safe haven for young adults to feel comfortable about their gender and sexuality, and also to learn from one another. **71.6% identify as heterosexual, 14.7% bisexual, 3.4% homosexual, 6.9% pansexual, and 3.4% choosing not to identify.**

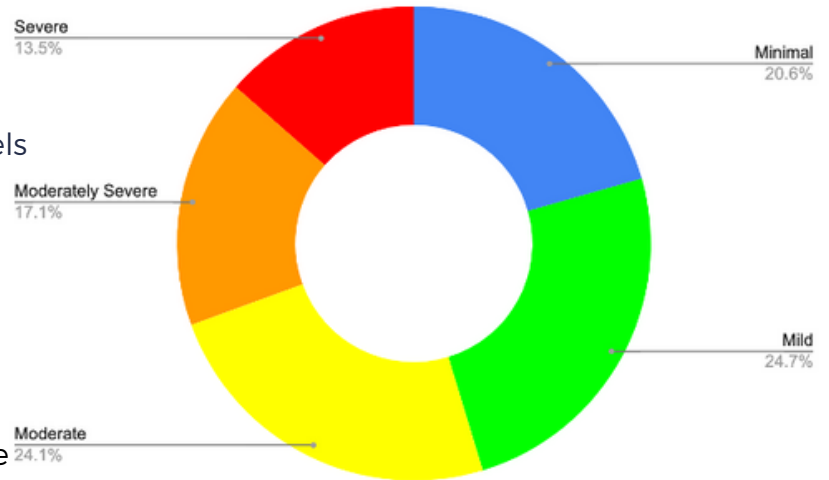

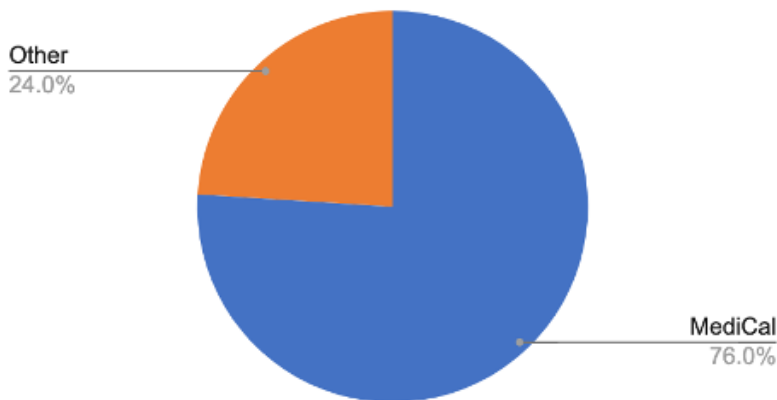
IMPACT OF PROGRAM

Each participant completes an industry-standard self-report questionnaire to measure their mental health at the time of entering the program. The questionnaire is provided every three months for updates.

- **69.4%** of participants have shown an improvement in their levels by going from severe and moderately severe depression to moderate, mild, and minimal depression.
- **89%** reported improved overall mental health.
- **88%** increased motivation to reduce substance use.



Health Coverage



*Nate's Place does not bill MediCal or any insurance company and there is no charge for services.

Participants that have attended programming 3 or more days each week have stated they are "Very Motivated" in reducing their use of alcohol and/or drugs.

As of June 2024, **76% of current Nate's Place participants are enrolled in Medi-Cal.** The young participants and their families benefit greatly from the free services and on-going support provided by Nate's Place: A Wellness and Recovery Center.
